This scholarship may also be used for tuition to attend a Pipe Organ Encounter (POE).

You must write a letter expressing your reasons for learning to play the organ. Include information about your musical training (keyboard, choral, instrumental) and about musical programs you have participated in at school, church or in the community.

Applications may be submitted at any time and will be considered at the next AGO board meeting.
